





A professional and functional space, the JTW room is equipped with everything you need for a successful meeting or conference. This room is flooded with natural light and guests can enjoy views of the River Thames.





The Churchyard and Millennium Courtyard


Stunning outdoor spaces for summer parties and drink receptions with impressive indoor areas in case the heavens open.

The Churchyard is a spacious outdoor area featuring beautifully manicured lawns, herbaceous borders and majestic York stone. Guests arrive through a dedicated entrance and can enjoy unbroken views of the Shard and the atmospheric hustle and bustle of neighbouring Borough Market. This space can hold up to 700 for a standing reception and can be hired in conjunction with the Nave.

The Millennium Courtyard is the perfect private outdoor area to enjoy an after work summer BBQ and cocktails, right in the heart of the vibrant local area. The Courtyard can also be transformed into a marquee reception space, seating 80 and 400 standing.










Our Location

We are located at the heart of London Bridge with excellent transport links:



By London Underground

Nearest stations

- London Bridge (Northern & Jubilee lines 0.1 mile, 3 min)
- Monument (Circle & District lines, 0.4 mile, 7 min)
- Bank (Central, Northern, DLR, Waterloo & City lines, 0.5 mile, 10 min)

By Rail

Nearest stations

London Bridge (0.1 mile, 3 min) Blackfriars (0.5 mile, 9 min) Cannon Street (0.5 mile, 10 min)

By Bus

Buses 17, 43, 35, 149, 47, 388, 344, 141, 21, 343, 381, 521, 141, 133 stop at London Bridge, London Bridge bus station or pass along Southwark Street - all 5 minutes walk or less.

By River

River bus services RB1, RB1X and RB2 all stop at London Bridge City pier, a 5 minute walk away.

By Bike

Cycle racks can be located on Montague Close outside the Cathedral perimeter. Several Santander cycle docking stations are located nearby.
