Principal Tasks

- Being on a rota of different roles, working flexibly across the Cathedral including (but not limited to); welcoming visitors, stewarding during religious ceremonies, commercial hires and cultural events, checking tickets, assisting during conferences and guided tours;
- Assisting the delivery of the highest standards in customer care to all visitors;
- Providing an inclusive welcome to all, to demonstrate our Cathedral values of diversity and inclusion;
- Showing people to their seats at any associated ticketed event and stewarding those attending services as required;
- Working alongside the Head Event Steward and other Cathedral staff to ensure all necessary health and safety measures have been adopted for the event or service;
- Being alert and vigilant throughout the event and assisting during first aid incidents, emergency evacuations or lock-downs should a situation occur;
- Being responsible for improving personal performance by undertaking training when necessary;
- Understanding the principles of people flow and dealing effectively with visitor access routes for events, event intervals and other pressure points;
- Abiding by Cathedral policies, including in relation to Equality and Diversity and Health and Safety.
- Ensuring all children & young people and vulnerable adults are safe and protected whilst onsite and be fully aware of Safeguarding reporting procedures.
