PRAYERS FOR PEACE IN THE HOLY LAND

On the first Friday of the month, initially until July, we invite you to gather from 12.00pm for a time of silent prayer for peace in the Chapel of St Francis and St Elizabeth, where the Cross of Nails calls us to focus on reconciliation. The prayer vigil will end with the regular Midday prayers, which, on Fridays, include the Coventry Litany of Reconciliation and for the next few months specific prayers for peace.

During this time of violence in the Holy Land, we encourage you to spend some time praying for an end to atrocities in Gaza and the West Bank, for the peace of Jerusalem and for the healing of the wounds of history.

You might like to light a candle as a sign of your prayer, as we ask God to shed the light of love in all the troubled corners of the world.

ANNUAL PAROCHIAL CHURCH MEETING 2024 & ELECTIONS

The Electoral Roll of the Cathedral will be revised for approval at the APCM on Sunday 19 May and a copy is available for inspection on request or by contacting Sarah Mann (Electoral Roll Officer) at sarah.mann@southwark.anglican.org. If you would like to join the Electoral Roll (see below for further details), please also contact Sarah Mann. The Roll closes for revision on 28 April and the revised Roll will be available for inspection from 5 May.

From 28 April, notices will be displayed at the South West door, the notice board and on the Cathedral website of the elections to take place at the APCM on Sunday 19 May. There are vacancies for Cathedral Wardens. Nominations close on Sunday 12 May at 5pm. Nomination forms are available at the West End; from Sarah Mann (sarah.mann@southwark.anglican.org); or may be downloaded from the Cathedral website.

ELECTORAL ROLL

If you are over 16, baptised, and resident in the parish, or have worshipped here regularly for 6 months or more, you are entitled to join the Electoral Roll. Joining the Electoral Roll is an important way of confirming your commitment to the Cathedral. It opens the way for you to participate in its governance and to vote at the Annual Parochial Church Meeting where elections take place for the Cathedral's representatives on Chapter and the Deanery Synod.
